Founded in 2006, The Resurgence Trust publishes *Resurgence & Ecologist* magazine. Its chair is James Sainsbury. The Trust's wider remit is to provide an active educational resource promoting the ideas and inspiration of the magazine and generate positive evolutionary change in the world. To this end it runs regular events, both in person and online, to inspire readers and members to put the ideas of the magazine into action.

Resurgence Trust events include an annual Summer Camp, a Festival of Wellbeing, Resurgence online talks and a variety of courses, workshops and retreats that promote the Trust's vision of a more ecologically sustainable and equitable world. These bring together a community of like-minded individuals and groups who believe a better way of life is possible.

On 12 September 2026, The Resurgence Trust is holding an event to celebrate 60 years of *Resurgence* magazine (now *Resurgence & Ecologist*). Entitled One with the Earth, it will take place at Wadham College, Oxford and will feature talks and discussions with leading international speakers and changemakers exploring ways to create a more resilient, peaceful world.

Resurgence & Ecologist, which has its roots in the peace movement, is published six times a year in print and online. The Resurgence Trust also publishes two world-leading environmental websites: www.resurgence.org and www.theecologist.org

The merger of *Resurgence* magazine with *The Ecologist* in June 2012 united two leading lights from the forefront of green publishing, offering a strong coherent voice for the whole environmental movement. Satish Kumar edited the magazine from 1973 to 2016 and continues his involvement with the charity in the role of editor emeritus and global ambassador. *Resurgence & Ecologist* magazine is now edited by Dave Reeve.

High-profile contributors to *Resurgence & Ecologist* have included Margaret Atwood, Jonathan Dimbleby, Antony Gormley and Annie Lennox, and its pages continue to carry the voices of many inspiring writers and changemakers.
