Two leading environmental charities – The Resurgence Trust and The Gaia Foundation – are jointly organising an event with two key environmentalists – Satish Kumar and Charles Eisenstein in conversation in Hampstead on 11 January. The evening will provide a fascinating look at the price we put on nature.

Satish Kumar is a former Jain monk and long-term peace and environmental activist. He is also editor-in-chief of *Resurgence & Ecologist* magazine.

Charles Eisenstein is a teacher, speaker and writer focusing on themes of civilization, consciousness, money and human cultural evolution. He is the author of *Sacred Economics* and other books. His article in the January/February 2013 issue of *Resurgence & Ecologist*, examines the value of nature.

Charles Eisenstein says: "It is surely a good thing to align money with ecology, but we must do that without reducing ecology to money. Nature to commodity, the infinite to the finite, the sacred to the profane, quality to quantity, and the world into a pile of instrumental stuff. Detaching financial incentives from the doctrine of value frees us to apply them flexibly on a case-by-case basis that fully recognises their social context."



Satish Kumar adds: "It is not rocket science to know that you cannot have unlimited economic growth on a finite planet, yet politicians, business leaders and policymakers appear unable to comprehend this simple fact. We may now have to learn from Nature. In Nature, everything moves in cycles: cycles of time, cycles of life and, of course, a cycle of seasons. Things begin, things grow, things decay and then begin again. This simple and obvious reality must now be placed at the centre of our thinking. Rather than a growth economy, we have to think in terms of a cyclical economy."
