Lunch is included: a South African braai at the lodge overlooking the 100 acre deer park, Romney Marsh and the English Channel, followed by more close encounters with various endangered species after lunch. The day safari will be led by Amos Courage who has been the Projects Director based in the UK for The Aspinnall.



Born in London in 1950, Antony Gormley has had a number of solo shows at venues including the Forte di Belvedere, Florence (2015); Zentrum Paul Klee, Bern (2014); Centro Cultural Banco do Brasil; Deichtorhallen Hamburg; State Hermitage Museum, St Petersburg; Kunsthaus Bregenz;

Hayward Gallery, London; Kunsthalle zu Kiel; Malmö Konsthall; and Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, Copenhagen. Major public works include the *Angel of the North* (Gateshead, England), *Another Place* (Crosby Beach, England) and *Exposure* (Lelystad, The Netherlands). He has also participated in major group shows such as the Venice Biennale and Documenta 8, Kassel, Germany. Gormley won the Turner Prize in 1994 and has been a member of the Royal Academy since 2003. He was made an Officer of the British Empire in 1997 and knighted in 2014.
